Corrimal High School will be in contact starting 16 August 2021, informing you of your child's application progress.

Enrichment Class Placement Test – **Monday 7 June 2021** at 2:00pm at Corrimal High School. Students are encouraged to arrive at least 10 minutes early to get settled. The testing period will last 1 hour.

Enrichment Class Placement Test Backup Date – **Monday 21 June 2021** at 2:00pm at Corrimal High School.

### **CORRIMAL HIGH SCHOOL 2022 ENRICHMENT CLASS APPLICATION**

In this test there are three sections to complete.

The first section is **General Ability** test with 15 questions.

The second section is a **Reading, Writing and Comprehension** test with 6 questions.

The third section is a **Writing Task**.

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Does your child love reading and writing? Loves to tinker with technology? Is curious about the world in which we live? Likes to challenge themselves and be creative? Then the Corrimal High School Enrichment Class is the place for them!**

#### **What is the Enrichment Class?**

The Enrichment Class has been in operation at Corrimal High School since 2009. The Enrichment Class is made up of students who are highly motivated to learn and who are dedicated to furthering their education. This class is not necessarily made up of students who gain the highest exam and NAPLAN results. Successful students entering the class will be exposed to additional/extended course content, differentiated assessments and field trips.

#### **How long will my child be in the Enrichment Class?**

With continued student application, the class remains the same throughout Years 7 and 8. Students stay in this class for their core subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Arts & Humanities, PDHPE and STEM, and they will be in different classes for electives: Music, Art, DAT and of course Sport.

#### **Why do we have to sit an examination?**

At Corrimal High School, we like to gauge student interest and motivation early to start to determine class lists. Our examination is designed in such a manner as to gauge general knowledge, literacy skills and most importantly, whether the student is suited and interested in being part of the class.

#### **What is the examination like?**

The examination is nothing to stress or worry over – we would not do that to you! The examination takes place in the Corrimal High School hall and we set aside 1 hour for you to complete 3 sections. The first section is general knowledge and numeracy, the second section is reading and comprehension where you will read a passage of text and write sentence answers. The third section is where you get to write a letter to the Principal, Mr Roger, outlining why you would like to be a part of the Enrichment Class.

#### **What happens if students do not make progress in the Enrichment Class?**

At Corrimal High School we have dedicated teachers and support staff who are always there to help students make progress. If students are motivated to learn and are engaged in their lessons, yet still not making academic progress they can be referred to Learning Support where diagnostic tests can be completed to see where specific tuition is required. Students not applying themselves to their studies may have their position in the program reviewed.
